	Storm Drain Cleanings — Alan reported about a meeting held on 9/1/22 with Carol, Greg, and Willie Owens, Superintendent Street Maintenance Division to discuss the problem with a private contractor, United Storm Water Inc., using the garden as an access to the city land on the east side of the gardens. The contractor tears down the fence in the SE corner of the gardens every 2 years. The heavy equipment damages the road and some of the facilities in the garden. The contractor does a very poor job of repairing the damage. Alan contacted the contractor directly to have a crew repair the fence and other damage including a pole which resulted in a water leak. 	We are asking Willie's department to look into an alternate location for the contractor to use to access the storm channel. Alan also asked Willie about items in the contract that are not being performed such as vegetation removal and fence repair. High palm tree recently had to be cut due to contact with power lines. There is low confidence that Willie's department will take any action on these issues and we will need to contact councilman Supernaw and the superintendent of parks.	No action
